
- μ 1. Remove the instrument panel lower panel.
 - 1 Remove the retaining screws.
 - 2 Release the retaining clips.




- μ 2. Detach the audio control switch from the steering column lower shroud (if equipped).
 - Using a thin bladed screwdriver, release the locking tang.




- μ 3. Remove the audio control switch (if equipped).
 - Disconnect the electrical connector.




- μ 4. Detach the steering column upper shroud.
 - 1 Using a thin bladed screw driver, release the two clips (one each side).
 - 2 Detach the shroud.




 μ 5. Remove the steering column upper shroud.




μ 6. Remove the steering column lower shroud.




μ 7. Remove the instrument cluster finish panel retaining screws. (Steering wheel shown removed for clarity).
